Thank you for your prayers, for your encouragement and for giving to the Rio Maria Project. The wall around the property is complete. The ground has been leveled. The plans have been finalized and the foundation is being poured.

Casa de La Luse (The House of Light) is on schedule to be complete just in time to house its first missions team from the United States in December.

While there, we were also able to purchase groceries for a widowed women in La Ceiba and while at her house we got the opportunity to pray for her and her granddaughter......as we were leaving I turned and saw the widow clinch her fist and share a big smile of joy. Even though there was a language barrier her face said it all, "God had blessed her and once again met her needs!" (It was better than a Tiger Woods fist pump!)

David shared the gospel at the drug rehab center in Buffalo (A place that many will not go because of the gangs.) and I got to lead

several of the men to Christ. Their stories were heart wrenching but we saw God move among those men and touch their lives forever. We also purchased food for those guys. They were able to enjoy the spiritual and the natural blessings of God.

On Sunday, I led worship and spoke at Sambo Creek Church.

The message was on Trusting God. Many came forward to be prayed for. His presence was evident in the place as His Spirit moved among the people.

Many practical things happened on this mission such as: working with the architect, determining the set back for the house and selecting the tile for the bathroom showers and the floors. Doing all of this made me want to go and build a house from scratch again.

Even upon my departure I was able to connect with a new found friend who pastors in the area. We plan to partner with him when we return. His team goes to hospitals and to the streets to pray for the sick and for those in need. I thank God for relationships.

I hope this will at least give you some idea of what's going on in a Honduras.
